

BELIZE PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

Adult Application (16 years and over)-Renewal of Damaged Passport

All documents must be submitted in their original form.

A passport is considered damaged as follows:

1. Partially Damaged - The bio data page is complete and readable and only visa pages have been affected, for example, torn or scratched or water damaged.
2. Mutilated – The bio-data page has been totally damaged and information is unreadable.

When seeking to replace a partially damaged or mutilated passport, applicants must submit all required documentation as when applying for a renewal of a passport.

Additionally, the following must be submitted:

3. Form 6, a declaration of lost, stolen or mutilated Belize passport – this is a standard form issued by the Immigration Department. Please complete all sections that apply to you.
4. Valid Photo Identification

Time Frame: 6 to 8 Weeks

FEES: US\$135.00 Payable by cash or money order made out to Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
